Brief rosjava Introduction

Java-based client library for ROS

- Enables ROS communication in Java
- Allows for running ROS on Android devices
- Not all core tools available yet (e.g. tf)
- Uses its own build system called *gradle*
- Encapsulates gradle repositories in catkin packages
- One gradle repository may contain multiple (sub)projects

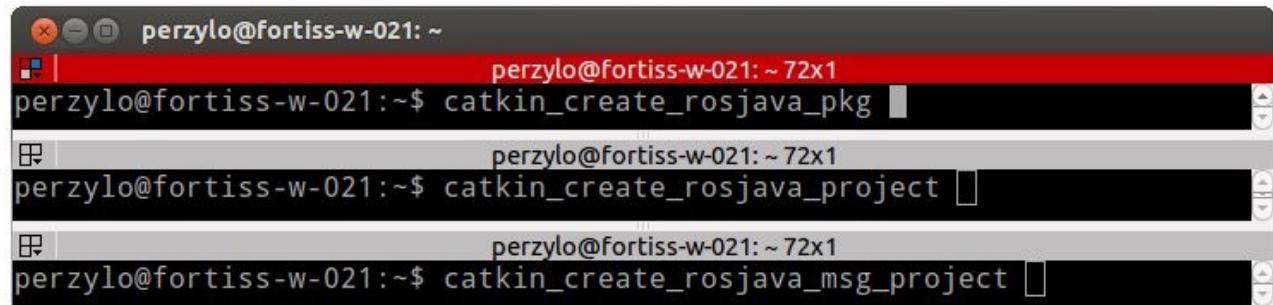
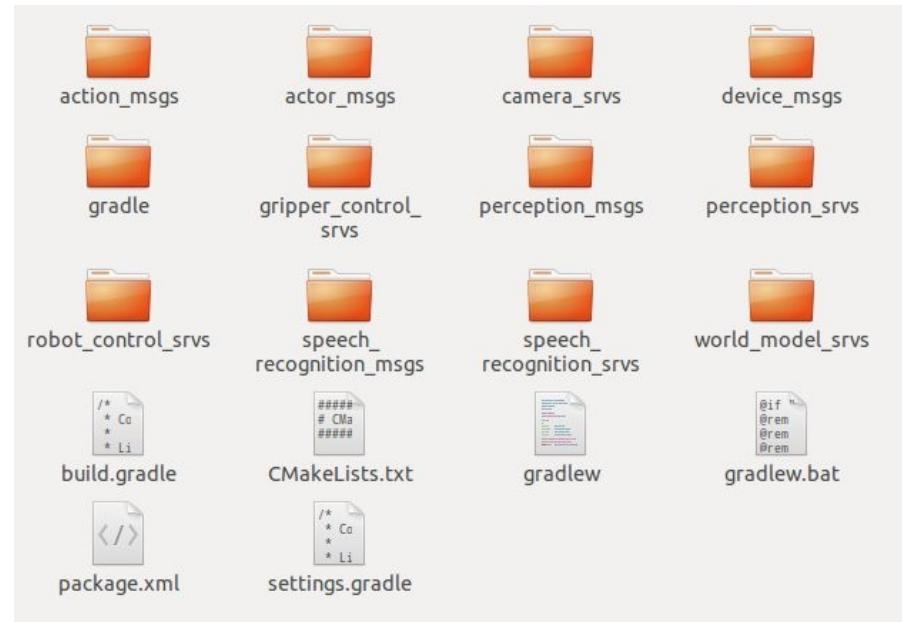
Content of ROS package rosjava_projects



- rosjava project *demo_cogsys_java*
- build system related files
- rosjava project *speech_recognition*
- rosjava project *utility*
- Gradle's build file
- Catkin's cmake file
- Gradle wrapper for building rosjava projects directly
- Gradle wrapper for building rosjava projects on windows
- Catkin's package description
- Gradle settings for specifying rosjava projects which shall be built

Content of ROS package rosjava_msgs_srvs

- rosjava requires Java versions of messages and services to be generated
- Use utility scripts to create rosjava
 - catkin packages
 - projects
 - msg/srv projects



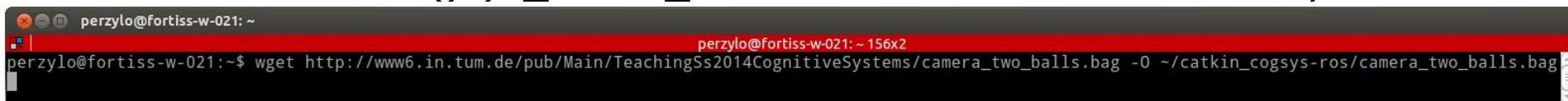

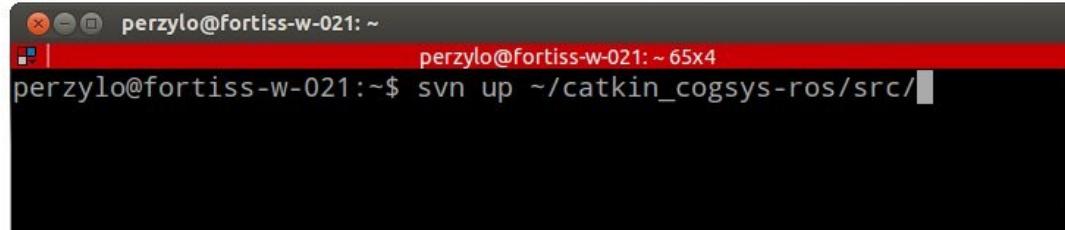

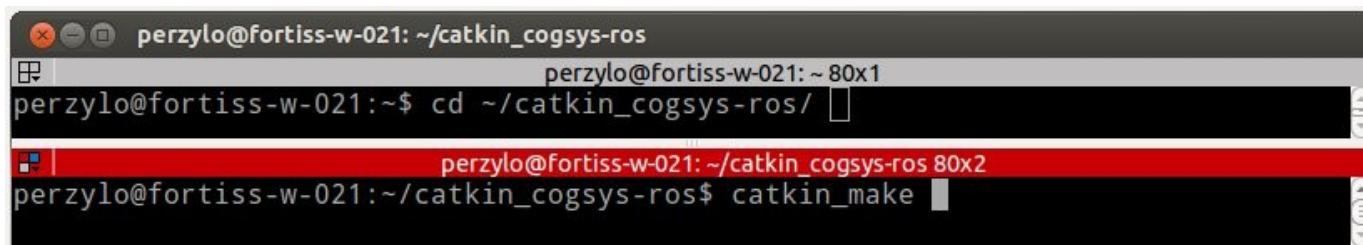

- Run *catkin_make* in *~/catkin_cogsys-ros/*

Today's exercise - Overview

- Pick-and-place tasks:
 - Functionality to be able to grasp objects of a user-specified color and put it into containers of a user-specified color.
 - Utility service in *world_model* which can be queried for a transform between different frames.
- Speech based instruction
 - Define grammar (in JSGF format) which enables recognition of certain utterances. Extend file `~/catkin_cogsys-ros/src/rosjava_projects/speech_recognition/grammar/grammar.gram`
 - Map analyzed speech to pick-and-place tasks

- World Model
 - *world_model/src/main_session4.cpp* : Implement two additional static transform publishers
 - *world_model/src/tflistener_helper.cpp* : Implement the callback function for the *world_model/get_transform* service.
- Demo program (*demo_cogsys_cpp_viz/src/main_session4.cpp*)
 - *pick(string object_name)* and *place(string container_name)* functions for 'pick-and-place' tasks
 - service clients for the *world_model/get_transform* service.
