

We are looking for $\underset{i}{\operatorname{arg max}} P(C = c_i \mid \mathbf{patch})$

If **patch** can be represented by a set of image features $\{f_i\}$:

$$P(C = c_i | \mathbf{patch}) = P(C = c_i | f_1, f_2, ..., f_n, f_{n+1}, ..., f_N)$$

which is proportional to

$$P(f_1, f_2, \dots f_n, f_{n+1}, \dots \dots f_N \mid C = c_i)$$

but complete representation of the joint distribution infeasible.


Naive Bayesian ignores the correlation:

$$\approx \prod_{j} P(f_j \mid C = c_i)$$

Compromise:

$$\approx P(f_1, f_2, \dots f_n \mid C = c_i) \times P(f_{n+1}, \dots f_{2n} \mid C = c_i) \times \dots$$






The tests compare the intensities of two pixels around the keypoint:

$$f_i = \begin{cases} 1 & \text{if } I(m_i) \leq I(m_i) \\ 0 & \text{otherwise} \end{cases}$$

Invariant to light change by any raising function.




