## Zonotopes

Zonotopes are set representations defined by

$$\mathcal{Z} = \{ \boldsymbol{c} + \sum_{i=1}^{p} \alpha_i \boldsymbol{g}^{(i)} | \alpha_i \in [-1, 1] \}, \boldsymbol{c} \in \mathbb{R}^n, \boldsymbol{g}^{(i)} \in \mathbb{R}^n$$

•  $\mathcal{Z}$  is the Minkowski sum of line segments  $I^{(i)} = [-1, 1]g^{(i)}$
