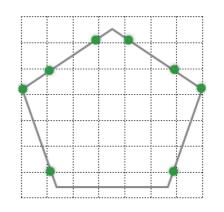


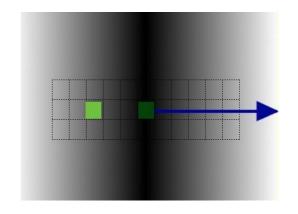
First Step: Edgel detection

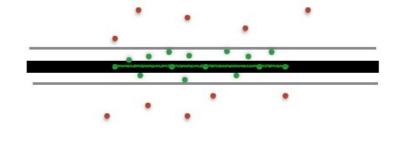




- 3. Ransac
- 4. Fit line





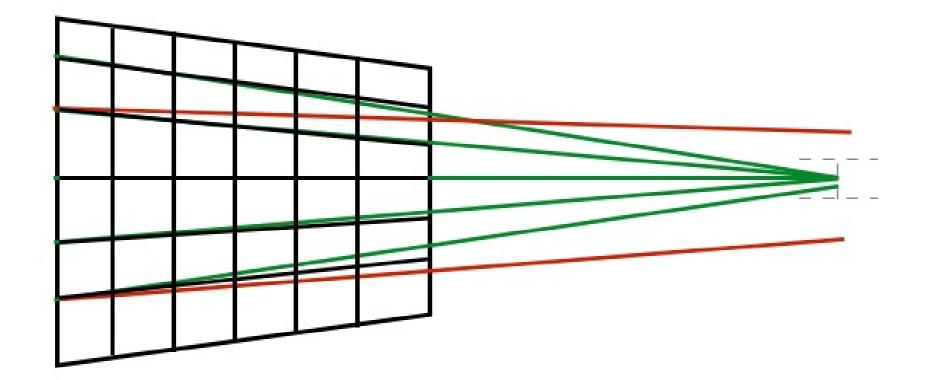


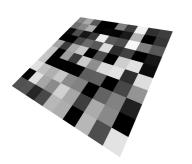




Second Step: Line grouping

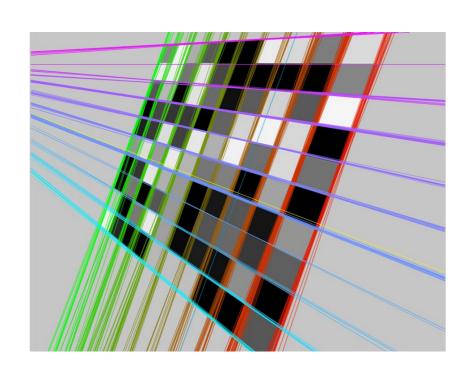
- Divide edgels into vertical and horizontal lines
- Homogeneous Coordinates
- Ransac Algorithm

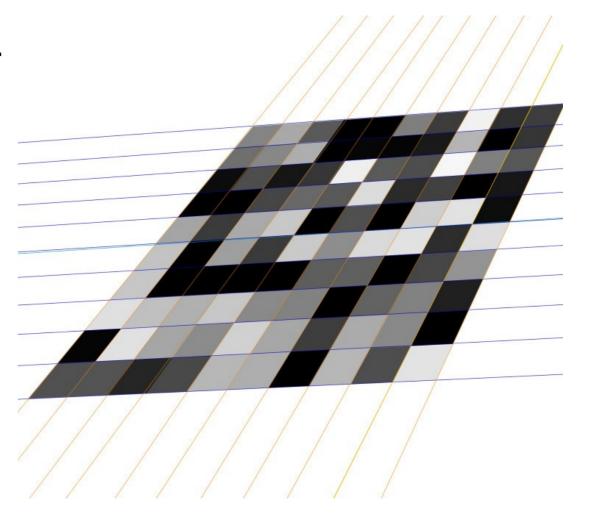


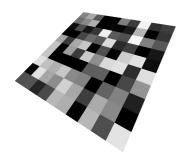


Third Step: Group clustering

- One line per grid index
- Mean shift filtering
- Mapping from line to cluster

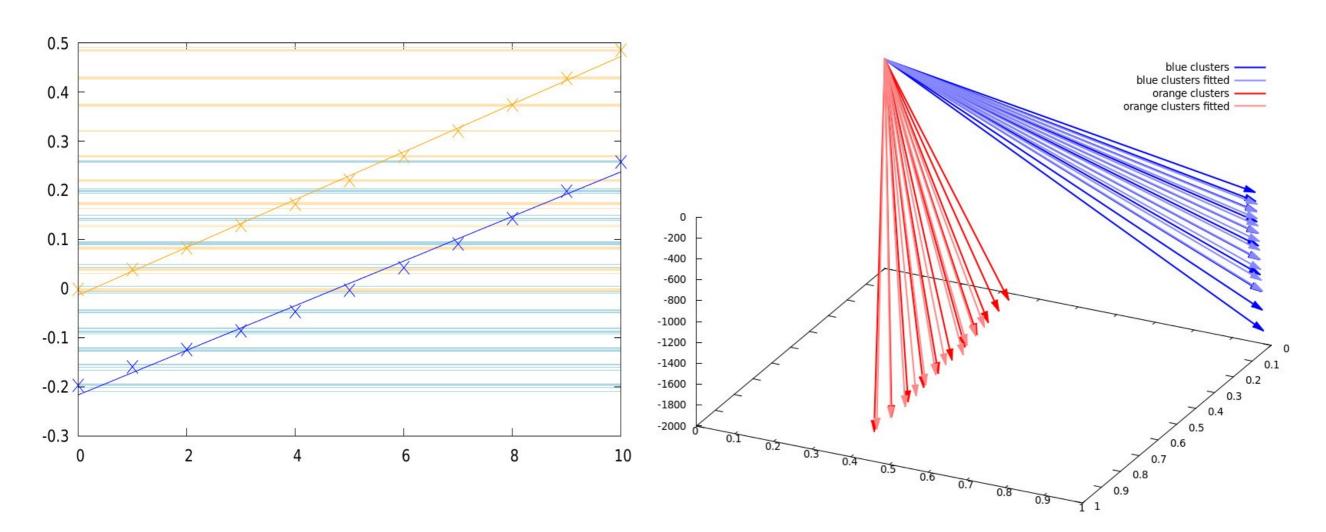






Fourth Step: Grid fitting

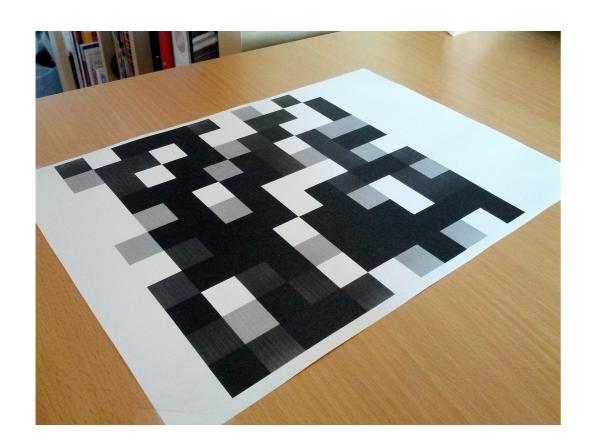
- Linear Regression of cluster lines
- Find grid equation: baseline + (k*i + q)*horizon

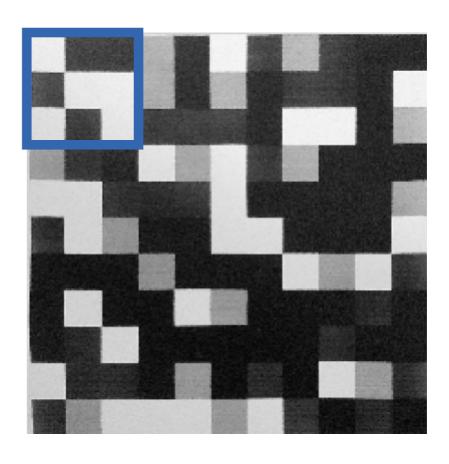




Fifth Step: Marker identification

- Estimate homography from grid corners
- Calculate shade differences & search decision tree

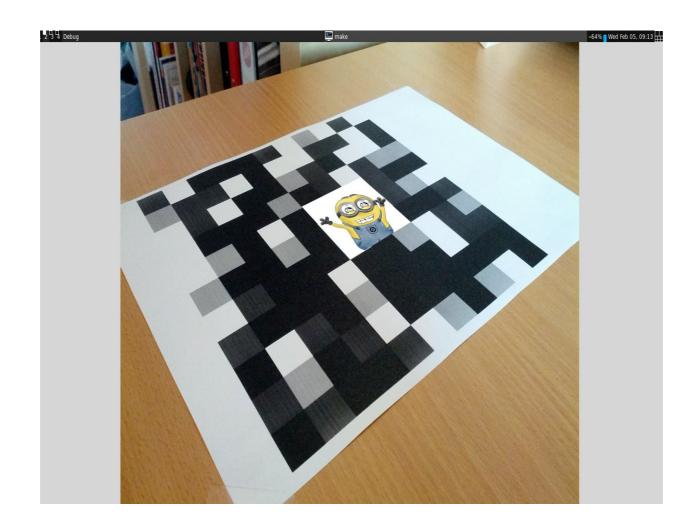






Sixth Step: Grid augmentation

Position & rotation within marker obtained from decision tree
