 Blender the Gazebo model



- Head orientation composition in slithering gait

 Calculate the swing angle of the first two head
 modules
 - o Use optimization method to composite the swing
 - o Simulate in Vrep
 - \circ If possible with the real snake robot.



- Downhill slope estimation based on IMU

 Use a car to simulate the downhill in V-REP
 Use EKF (Extened Kalman Filter) to predict the slope angle.
 - Lear KF and EKF
 - Build reasonable model to predict the angle
